



Chilliwack Middle School Hockey Skills Academy Program Expectations and Commitment



Behaviour:

The Chilliwack Middle School Hockey Skills Academy Program places equal importance on both on-ice success and off-ice success. To be accepted into, and to participate in, the Chilliwack Middle School Hockey Skills Academy Program, students are expected to maintain a satisfactory academic standing for all of their courses. Students are also expected to adhere to the behavioural expectations of their teachers, coaches, and administrators. Students in this program must have exceptional school attendance, must participate well in class, and must complete all necessary homework and assignments. Should your son/daughter not be able to meet these expectations, or not take the steps necessary to achieve them, we will reserve the right to suspend their participation in the Chilliwack Middle School Hockey Skills Academy Program until they are once again able to meet these expectations.

Students in the Chilliwack Middle School Hockey Skills Academy Program are expected to behave responsibly. Foul language, poor sportsmanship, or a poor attitude toward the Program, its participants, or its staff will not be accepted. There will be zero tolerance for any hurtful behavior toward others or any behavior which does not meet the expectations of Chilliwack Middle School and your son's/daughter's home school. We expect cooperative behaviour, the encouragement of others, and respectful peer interactions from all of our student athletes.

Hockey is a physical competitive sport at all levels and accidents can occur due to the nature of the activity. By allowing your son/daughter to participate in this activity, you are accepting the risk of an accident occurring, and agree that participation in the Chilliwack Middle School Hockey Skills Academy Program is suitable for your child. Should there be an injury on the ice that requires medical attention, the parents/guardians listed on the student's application form will be contacted immediately.

Equipment:

Students are expected to provide all necessary hockey equipment, including certified protective gear in good condition. Students must wear a helmet with full-face protection and a neck guard at all times while on the ice. Students will not be allowed to participate if they arrive without these items. All students in the Chilliwack Middle School Hockey Skills Academy Program will have access to a storage locker at Prospera Center to store their equipment during the day. Dependent on enrollment, some student may be required to share a locker. These lockers are for day use only and all equipment should be removed from the locker at the end of the school day. It is the student's responsibility to make sure that their equipment is picked up from Prospera Centre each day.

Chilliwack Middle School will not be held liable for any loss of Chilliwack Middle School Hockey Skills Academy students' equipment either at Prospera Centre or at the school.

Chilliwack Middle School will not be responsible for, nor will it insure, any equipment left in the storage lockers at Prospera Centre.
